

# Tottori Hanakairo Guide Map

You can enjoy a relaxing time even on a rainy day, as there is a huge 21-meter tall, 50-meter diameter glasshouse, and a 1 km circumference covered observatory gallery.

## 5. Flower Dome

The giant greenhouse is 50 meters in diameter and 21 meters high. It is Tottori Hanakairo's main feature.



Tropical and subtropical plants such as Cuban royal palm, tropical orchids and hibiscus provide glorious colors throughout the year.

## 11. Observatory Gallery

The covered 1 km gallery circles the park. After taking a round of the flat gallery, you can enjoy a variety of views from 30 meters above ground to the underground tunnel and the waterfall over the roof.



## 6. North Wing (Kutsurogi-no-yakata)

At the theater, you can enjoy in moving images the allure and power of nature, including those of Mt. Daisen. The fourth floor is an admission-free observatory and rest area, and there is also a tea area.



## 13. European Garden

The European-style garden has an outdoor stage and fountain.

- Outdoor concerts are held (during events)
- There is a rose garden. (May to June, and October to November are the heights of season)

You will find native wild flowers and lilies. There are also many birds.

### 19. Furusato-no-komichi

Lilies bloom along the gentle curving trail in the forest.

### 20. Forest Trail

The trail takes you up the densely wooded forest from the valley with a brook.

### 21. Cherry Plaza

The plaza has many cherry trees. You can enjoy riotously blooming cherry blossoms in the spring.

A field with flowers blooming throughout the four seasons against Mt. Daisen.

The wing at the entrance to the park consists of the ticket sales booth, the entrance gate, the information center, a waiting room and a baby nursing room. Strollers and wheelchairs are also available to rent.

## 8. Sugi-no-yakata

Seminar room in the Japanese cedar forest. Barbeque can also be enjoyed. (May to September, booking is essential)

## 15. Grace Garden (garden with fruit trees and phlox)

The corner is mainly planted with phlox. Enjoy observing the growth of the plant.



14 Mist Garden

Mists are sprayed from the center of the garden. The hanging baskets add colors.

## Picnic area

There are about 300 wooden tables and benches. It can be used on a rainy day as the area is covered. You can enjoy your lunch here.

## 10. South Wing (Jungle Dome)

The egg-shaped greenhouse is full of tropical and subtropical plants. There is a slope that connects the first floor with the second floor, and the trees can be enjoyed from all angles.



## 16. Herb Garden & Clematis Gallery

The medicinal properties and usage of herbs are displayed in an easy-to-understand manner at the Herb Garden. There is a permanent exhibit of clematis that surrounds the garden, and it is the largest of its kind in Western Japan, at 100 meters (May to June is the height of season).



## 17. Floating Flower Beds

Above the 40-meter diameter pond, there are flower beds arranged over a latticed grid planted with seasonal blooms.
